

Blue Wire Film Festival Rules and Regulations

Films that meet the following criteria are eligible to submit to the Blue Wire Film Festival 2010.

1. Films that were completed after January 1, 2006.
2. This film is open to shorts, features, documentary, children's, family, experimental, animation and international films.
3. Films no matter how they were shot must have final project on VHS or DVD for screening.
4. Films that are in a foreign language must have English subtitles.
5. Each participant is require to submit an application, a clearly labeled VHS or DVD (NTSC Standard), with title, contact name, phone number and email address, and run time; as well as a 150 word synopsis of the film.
6. If your film is chosen for screening you will be required to submit a press kit including a film poster, bio and picture of the director.
7. Should entry be selected the filmmaker guarantees that permission has been secured from the rights holder for screening at the festival as well as the images associated with the project to be printed in the festival program as well as the festival website.
8. Copies will not be returned unless a self addressed stamped envelope is provided.
9. The festival takes no responsibility in the case of accidental damage or loss, except for the actual time the entries are in the possession of the festival organizers. Postal and shipping is at the participant's own risk and expense.
10. Entrants will be notified of acceptance starting the first week in June.
- 11.** All entrants will receive email notification that their film has been received.
- 12.** Make Money Orders and Cashier's Checks out to Blue Wire Film Festival. (Online payments will be available soon.)
